Effective from 1 January 2022 for various services in connection with your savings.

As part of your basic account service	Unpaid cheques	To cover the cost of a payment being returned and subsequent administration.	£10
	Unpaid standing orders/internal transfers	To cover the cost of attempting to resend the standing order/internal transfer up to a maximum of 3 attempts.	£10
	Telegraphic transfer fee (CHAPS)	For the electronic transfer of monies.	£25
	Replacement passbook	To cover the cost of a replacement passbook.	£5
If you ask us for extra documentation and/or services beyond the standard management of your account	Duplicate S975 tax statement	To cover the cost of producing a duplicate S975 tax statement (one will be provided free of charge each year).	£5
	Duplicate investment transaction statement	To cover the cost of producing a duplicate investment transaction statement (one will be provided free of charge each year).	£5
	Historical information	To cover the cost of producing information requested.	Up to £50

Transaction limits: The Society has transaction limits in place. Where these are breached, additional charges become payable.

Branch cash withdrawals (on demand)	£500 per day, per customer
Branch cash withdrawals (5 business days' notice)	£5,000 per week, per customer
Branch cash receipts (coinage)	Up to 5 bags per week, per customer
Branch cheque withdrawals	5 per week, per customer (50p per item thereafter)
Branch cheque receipts	5 per week, per customer (50p per item thereafter)
Branch cash receipts	20p per £100 above the weekly limit of £2,500
